EELISA has been awarded a European University grant in 2020 by the European Commission. The Alliance is meant to define and implement a common model of European engineering rooted in society. To do so, EELISA aims to transform European higher education by:

- Re-inventing the “European engineer”
- Democratizing engineering education
- Evolving interdisciplinary engineering learning
- Encouraging knowledge, skills and technology transfer
- Fostering inclusiveness and diversity
- Making a real impact on society following the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and the SDGs
- Innovating Engineering education

### Missions of the EELISA Dean of Studies

As stated in the Grant Agreement, the Dean of Studies will play a key role in coordinating, integrating and supervising all the academic work within the Alliance. Emphasis will be put on those topics: the European Engineer and the European Degree during the first phase of the Alliance.

He/She has to:

- plan and organise the work related to the European Engineer profile and the European Degree to lead in order to:

- Foster a consensual definition of the European Engineer, and its consequent Learning Outcomes
- Develop a path of the implementation of a joint European Degree in engineering within EELISA
- support the development of the partnership framework and outcomes: charter for automatic mutual recognition of qualification and periods abroad, EELISA credential, EELISA supplement, EELISA degree
- identify, make suggestions about topics that require coordination between the different bodies / work packages / work groups of EELISA, EELISA-InnoCORE and EELISA Unfolds on academic related issues
- provide advice on the above-mentioned matters to the different EELISA boards
- monitor the development at European level of the above-mentioned matters
- promote the EELISA vision of the European Engineer/Degree
- contribute to reporting activities requested by the Erasmus+ programme
- write or help write the reports, deliverables and other documents required for EELISA academic cooperation

The Dean of Studies while based in Paris at Université PSL (Chimie ParisTech PSL) will be part of the EELISA Office team located in Madrid. Together with the Executive Director, he/she will coordinate all the operational activities and cooperation academic programs of the EELISA and will report to the EELISA Coordinator and the Executive board.
