

ABOUT PROFESSOR ANDRÁS PATARICZA:

He is a full professor at the Budapest University of Technology and Economics, graduated in electrical engineering. He received his D.Sc. title from the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (MTA) and Dr.Habil. from BME. The Fault-Tolerant System Research Group, founded by him in 1994, is one of the most successful groups in tutoring research students, as indicated by the many awards won by the students. He led the Computer Science and Engineering Branch of the National Council of Student Research for a decade. He served as a visiting professor at the FAU Erlangen, TU Darmstadt, University of Florence, and the Brazilian National Institute for Space Research. Prof. Pataricza has received multiple recognition awards from different scientific and industrial organizations, like the Academic Award of the MTA and six IBM Faculty Awards. The President of Hungary honored him with an Officer's Cross of Hungarian Order of Merit. He has also received the "Pro Scientia Honoris Causa" award (the highest recognition of the National Council of Student Research).
