

Study at BME

The BME (Budapest University of Technology and Economics) is the leading technical university of Hungary, with its 8 faculties covering various fields from civil engineering to electrical engineering and informatics to economic and social sciences. Apart from the Hungarian language training, it offers a range of courses in English and even in German. About 12% of all students come from abroad, representing nearly 50 countries of the world.

The Department of International Relations is in charge of managing mobility programmes at all levels, with the Central Academic Office providing assistance in issues such as registrations, study certificates or documents receipts.

The Directorate of Student Services can help students with counselling including psychology and equal opportunities, and medical service is also available for foreign students. They can also turn to the International Mentor Team of current or former BME students, whose task is to give support from the day of arrival.
