## TRANSPORT INFORMATION

---



### Metro

Tickets for the Madrid Metro can be purchased easily at all stations using automated ticket machines, which are available in several languages. To travel, you will first need to buy a rechargeable Multi Card, which costs EUR 2.50. This card can be used by one or more passengers and can be topped up with different types of tickets.

The most common option is a single journey ticket, with prices typically ranging from EUR 1.50 to EUR 2.00 depending on the number of stations travelled. For journeys to or from the airport, an additional supplement of EUR 3 applies. Alternatively, travellers may choose a 10-journey ticket, which offers a more economical option for multiple trips. Payments can be made by cash or bank card at the machines. It is recommended to keep the card for the duration of your stay, as it can be reused and recharged as needed.

### Bus

EMT MADRID

Tickets for EMT buses in Madrid can be purchased directly on board from the driver. The standard fare is EUR 1.50 per journey, and payment can be made in cash (small amounts) or by contactless card or mobile payment. In addition, the Multi Card can also be used if it has been previously loaded with valid tickets.

## Transportation from the airport

- **Public Transport (Connection with the city center)**



### METRO LINE 8

The Metro is often the most convenient option for travelling around the city, particularly if you are carrying light luggage. Madrid-Barajas Airport is directly linked to Nuevos Ministerios Station via Metro Line 8. The journey takes approximately 22 minutes and costs EUR 3 per trip, you will need to buy the ticket at the entrance of the metro station. Metro stations are located in Terminals 2 and 4 of the airport. If you arrive at Terminal 1 or 3, a free shuttle bus is available to take you to Terminals 2 and 4. The Metro operates daily from 06:00 to 01:30. This line also provides a direct connection to the event venue.

### BUS. LINE AIRPORT EXPRESS.

A 24-hour express bus service connects Madrid-Barajas Airport with the city centre. The service is easily identifiable by its yellow buses, which depart from stops located just outside Terminals 1, 2, and 4. Passengers arriving at Terminal 3 may use the free inter-terminal shuttle bus to reach Terminal 2, or alternatively walk. The journey to the city centre takes approximately 50 minutes, and the cost is EUR 5. Tickets can be purchased directly on board using cash, bank card, or mobile payment.

- **Ride-Sharing: Uber, Bolt and local taxis are available in Madrid**
